

Hospice Mississauga – Bed Race Committee Position Description

The Event

Join us for Hospice Mississauga's 2nd Annual Bed Race on Wednesday, October 7, 2026 at Sherwood Village. This high-energy event brings together teams, supporters, and local champions for a day of unforgettable fun and friendly competition as participants sprint decorated, specialty race beds down the course, battling for the fastest times and ultimate bragging rights at the finish line. As Hospice Mississauga receives only 50% of its funding from the government, events like the Golf Classic play a vital role in sustaining the free programs and services we provide to individuals and families facing life-limiting illness, caregiving journeys, and grief. **Our goal is to raise \$75,000 gross.**

Purpose of the Committee

The **Bed Race Committee** will work collaboratively with the Event Manager to engage the community, secure sponsorships, manage logistics, and promote the event to achieve the event goals.

Roles & Responsibilities

We are looking for a Chair (Lead the Committee), Vice Chair (Assist the Chair) and general Committee Members.

The Golf Classic Committee shall assist the Fund Development Team on the following items and objectives:

- Identify and secure sponsorships (both financial and Gift-In-Kind to offset costs), partners, donors, and fundraising opportunities.
- 2. Promote and market the event through various communication channels.
- 3. Engage community stakeholders, partners, and volunteers to enhance event impact.
- 4. Evaluate the event's success and recommend improvements for future iterations.
- 5. Have relevant skills, experience, and community connections to support the event.

Meetings

The Committee will meet monthly leading up to the event, with increased frequency as needed in the final weeks before the bed race. These meetings will be in person and have the option to join remotely and will take approximately 1 hour per meeting.
